MAGAZINE ARTICLES

Academic Search Premier Full text database of peer-reviewed academic journals, offering critical information from many sources found in no other database. Not only does it contain full text articles from over 2,940 scholarly publications, but one can also find abstracts and indexing for nearly 3,930 scholarly journals. The journals offered cover nearly all areas of study. (EBSCOhost)

🌐 EBSCOhost Education Group databases - Search one or more of EBSCOhost education databases simultaneously.

🌐 Encyclopedia of Animals - A database with over 2,200 entries about mammals, birds, reptiles, amphibians, fish and dinosaurs. (EBSCOhost)

🌐 ERIC - Information culled from the journals Current Index to Journals in Education and Resources in Education Index. Designed for teachers, students, administrators, researchers and others interested in the field of education. Full text of over 2,200 digests, including references for even more information. Citations and abstracts from over 980 educational and education-related journals. (EBSCOhost, First Search)

🌐 Primary Search Designed for elementary schools and children's reading rooms, this database contains World Almanac of the USA and World Almanac for Kids, searchable full text from over 50 of the most popular K-12 magazines, abstracts and indexing for over 180 titles and pamphlets. Also included are Funk and Wagnall's New Encyclopedia, the Encyclopedia of Animals, and many charts, tables and graphs converted to ASCII text in order to retain the original meaning of featured articles. (EBSCOhost)

🌐 Professional Development Collection A valuable resource aimed primarily at professional educators and others interested in the field of education. Information on everything from child development to theories and practices of different teaching methods. The database includes full text from 440 journals (150 with images), and abstract and index coverage for 530 professional development titles. (EBSCOhost)

🌐 What do I read next? - This database includes books that are award winners, bestsellers, or have been included in recommended reading lists. Book lovers of all ages can use this tool to find more reading adventures. Searching can be based on subject, genre, time period, character, reading level, and more. Books are separated into eight different genres: Science Fiction, Inspirational, Mystery, Romance, Fantasy, Horror, Western and historical novels, and General fiction, classic fiction, and non-fiction.
