### **\*\*ONLINE CARD CATALOG ([EAGLIT](#))\*\***

The online card catalog is a good place to start.

1. Select **Subject** from the pull down tab menu or from the blue tabs.
2. Enter subject heading. Examples: Drug; Alcohol; Addictive Behavior.

### **\*\* REFERENCE BOOKS \*\***

- **Alcohol and temperance in modern history : an international encyclopedia**; Call # REF HV5017 A43 2003
  - Provides international articles, national/regional articles, and specific articles that focus on topics ranging from the use of alcohol in different societies to alcohol regulations around the world.
- **Handbook of the Medical Consequences of Alcohol and Drug Abuse**; Call # REF RC564 H3585 2008
  - A detailed reference book containing information on the use and consequences of the most commonly used drugs.
- **The Alcohol/Drug Abuse Dictionary and Encyclopedia**; Call # REF RC564 F39 1988
  - Defines over 1,400 terms, phrases, and concepts related to drug and alcohol abuse. Entries are in alphabetical order and are easy to use.

- **Alcohol Information for Teens: Health Tips about Alcohol and Alcoholism;** Call # REF HV5135 A412 2005
  - Includes facts about underage drinking, preventing teen alcohol use, alcohol's effect on the brain and the body, and more.
- **The War on Drugs: An International Encyclopedia;** Call # REF HV5804 C47 1999
  - Covers the legal, political, social, economic, and environmental aspects of the international drug trade and the war on drugs.

**\*\* DATABASES \*\***

**Health and Wellness Resource Center** - Instant access to carefully compiled and trusted medical reference resources such as Gale Encyclopedia of Medicine, Gale Encyclopedia of Childhood and Adolescence, and PDR Family Guide to Health and Nutrition. Key health web sites are also listed here, as well as 2,200 general interest health publications, and over 400 health and medical journals. Reliable information can be found by searching under latest news, subject, or key words.

**National Criminal Justice Reference Service (NCJRS)** - is a federally funded resource offering justice and substance abuse information to support research, policy, and program development worldwide.

**Criminal Justice Abstracts** - This database contains comprehensive coverage of international journals, books, reports, dissertations, and unpublished papers on criminology and related disciplines. The database contains indexes and summaries of international journal articles, books, and governmental and non-governmental reports on virtually any topic in criminal justice.

**Psychology and Behavioral Science Collection** - Over 450 full text articles covering the topics of emotional and behavioral characteristics, psychiatry & psychology, mental processes, anthropology, and much more. The database includes many PDF images and 350 peer reviewed journals.

**Criminal Justice Periodicals Index**- Proquest's CJPI can provide information on virtually any criminal justice topic. The database offers ASCII text, image, and Text+Graphics coverage for about 50 of the titles most frequently accessed by criminal justice researchers. CJPI also include complete indexing and abstracts for another 140 relevant U.S. and international journals. This is updated weekly.
